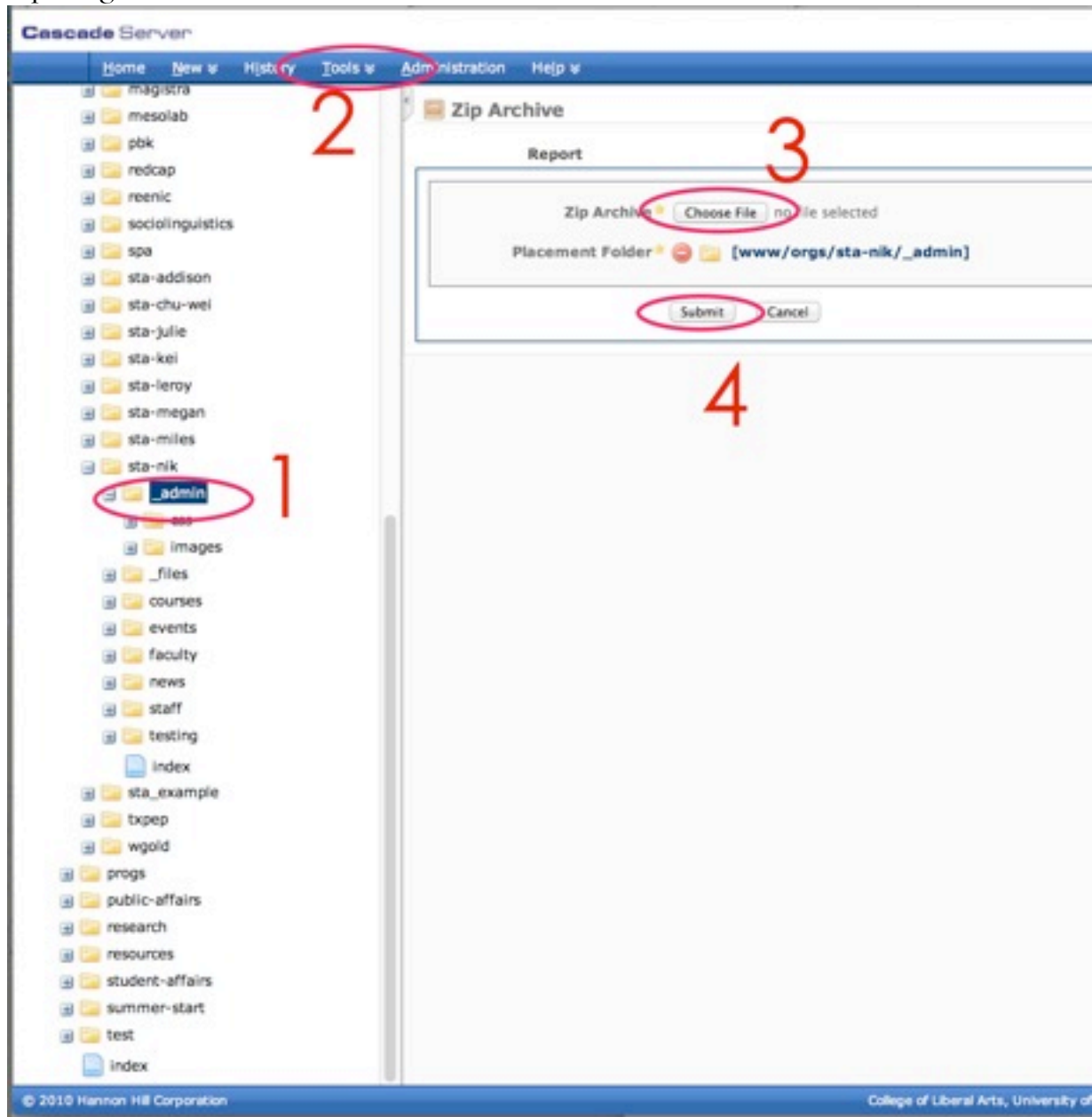

Procedures

- Have your psd design ready for importing to cascade:
 1. Save all your design assets in "_designassets" folder
 2. Tweak "custom.css" if necessary (you can also modify css after uploading it to Cascade)
 3. In the _admin folder, you should have two subfolders, "css" and "images". Please put the updated image assets in the images folder.
 4. Compress both folders into an "Archive.zip" file.
- Upload zip file to cascade:

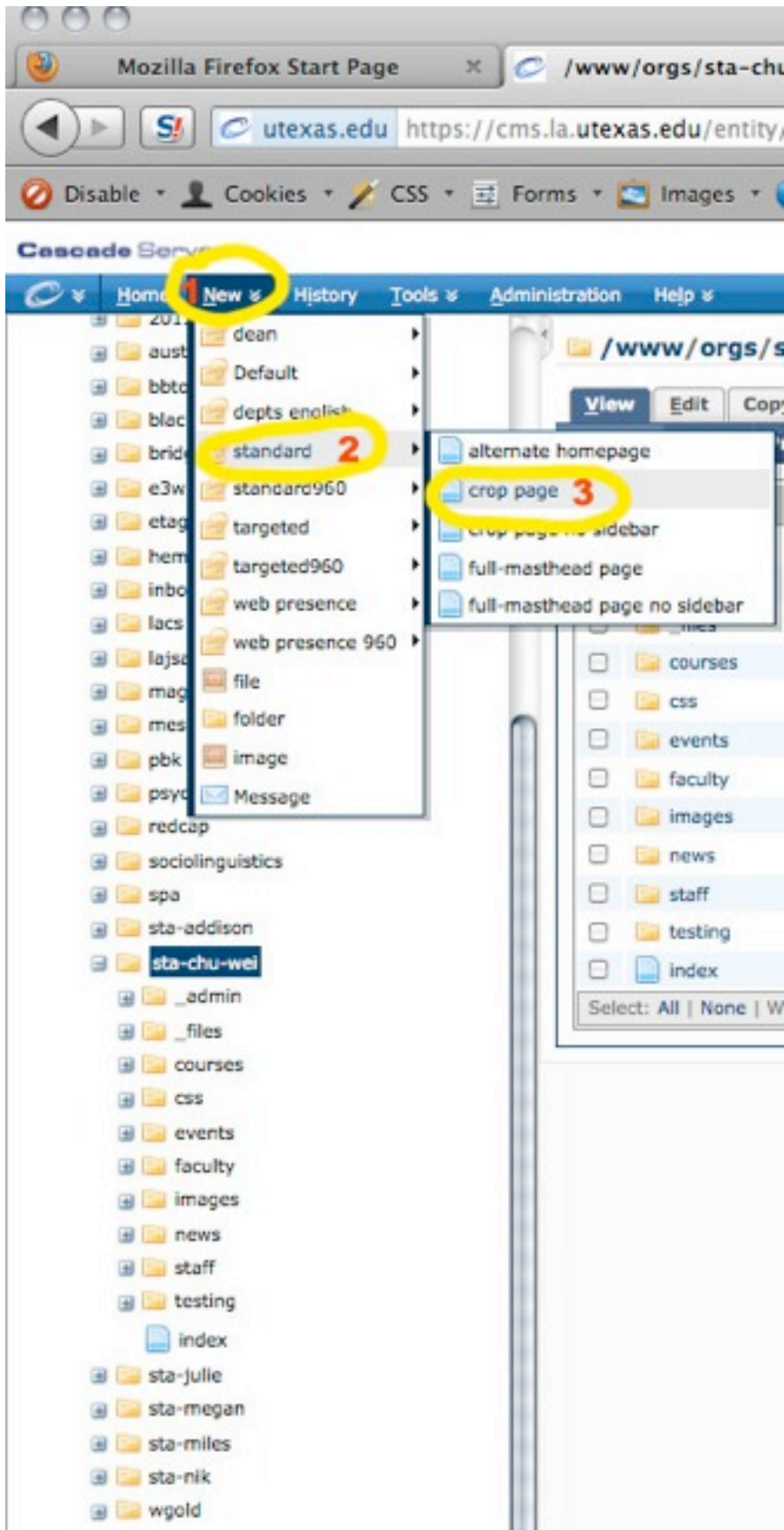
- i. In Cascade site, first click on “sta-nik” > _admin in the left column, then click on “tools” from the top navigation bar.



2. Upload your Archive.zip file. Hit “publish” and then “submit”
3. See you live site at <http://www.utexas.edu/cola/orgs/sta-nik/index.php>

- Add a new page and Edit it:

- i. In the top navigation bar, click on”new” > “standard” > “crop page” to add a new page to this 800 width template



2. Edit the page and when you are done, hit “summit” at the bottom of the page.
3. The page has been created, but it also needs to be published. To publish the page, please click on “publish”
